

How to Install the Gimp at Home

1. Go to <http://www.gimp.org>
2. Click on “Gimp for Windows” in the left-hand column.
3. Click on “Automated Installer”.
4. Click on “Download” in the left-hand column.
5. You need to download and install both the GTK+2 and The Gimp for Windows. Click on the download links to download each file. Save it in a place where you can find it easily once it’s downloaded. The desktop is usually a good place.
6. After both downloads have completed, double-click on the GTK+2 program to install it first.
7. Once you have finished installing that, double-click on the Gimp program to install it.
8. As you are going through and installing each of the programs, when it asks you questions, if you don’t know what to choose just select the default option.
9. After it has finished installing, start the Gimp and have fun!
