

Signing Up For Hosting at FreeHostingCloud.com

1. Go to www.freehostingcloud.com
2. Under FREE HOSTING, click on “ORDER!”
3. Select “I want to use a FREE subdomain”.
4. Your site is going to use what’s called a subdomain of freehostingcloud.com. Type in what you’d like yours to be. Choose something that will be easy to remember and share with others so they can check out your website. I picked mrbrandl.freehostingcloud.com. You may have to try a few different things if your first choice is already taken. Write it down here so you don’t forget:

5. Click the blue >> button.
6. It will ask you to provide a description of what your website will be about. Type something to the effect, “This is my first website. I’ll be sharing some things that I like.”
7. Click on the “UPDATE CART” button.
8. Next it will tell you that you owe \$0.00. Click on the “CHECKOUT” button.
9. Fill in the new customer form which includes selecting a password. Be sure to choose something that you can remember! Also, be sure to click in the check box for the Terms of Service.
10. After you’ve completed the form, click “COMPLETE ORDER”.
11. It will let you know that you’ve successfully completed the order. Then click, “CONTINUE.”
12. Now you can start working with your site in step #3 below.

Uploading Files to Change Your Site

1. To login to your account to upload files go to www.freehostingcloud.com
2. Type in your email address and password on the left and click “Login”.
3. In the middle of the page under *Website Control Panel*, click the “Login” button next to your web address.
4. Click on “File Manager” in the left column.
5. Click on the “html” folder. This folder contains the files that make up your website.
6. To upload a file, click “Upload” in the *Tools*: list at the top.
7. The upload tool is now available at the bottom of the window. Click “Browse...” to select the file you want to upload. If you are replacing a file that you’ve already uploaded, be sure that “Overwrite” is selected.
8. You can also upload several files at one time, using the “Multiple Upload” in the middle bottom of the page.
9. Pay attention to the Status at the bottom which will let you know if the uploads have been successful.
